The 1994 King Faisal international Prize for Science (Mathematics) has been awarded to:

PROFESSOR DENNIS PARNELL SULLIVAN (USA)

Professor Sullivan is an American scientist who was born in Port Huron, Michigan, in 1941. He received his Ph.D. in Mathematics from Princeton University in 1965.

Professor Sullivan began his career in geometry. With the assistance of his powerful imagination he was able to provide an understanding of complicated structures. In recent years he has combined analytical and geometrical methods to develop sound mathematical foundations for the study of complex dynamical systems which relate to some of the most intractable and important problems in the field.

Professor Sullivan is the Albert Einstein Professor at the City University of New York and a professor at the Institut des Hautes Etudes Scientifiques in France. He is a member of the US Academy of Sciences, Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and a Vice-President of the American Mathematical Society.
